Agenda/Minutes

- 2024 face to face committee meeting (OSM, Louisiana back2back)
 - For the face2face Committee Meeting in February Chairs and TC drafted some items and suggested a structure: [GO-SHIP7-DraftAgendaV2.docx](#)
 - Meeting is kindly funded by NOAA-GOMO, Kathy Tedesco, Venue Doubletree close to Convention Center. 35 in U shape. Times for coffee breaks, and final list of participants, required in Jan
 - Committee Members were requested to provide comments in the draft agenda, and any status updates regarding their on-site participation or secondments
 - Facilities for high-end audio and video-conferencing have been quoted. Very expensive. Decision to what extent the meeting should be hybrid will be taken at later stage.
 - Consider “code of conduct during GO-SHIP cruises” on agenda
 - If invitation letters are required to facilitate travel application, reach out to TC
 - Reminder that OSM will comprise a GO-SHIP session (chaired by Alison) and Town Hall

- National reports
 - JMA: no changes
 - Jamstec: Application for P4W in 2025 submitted
 - Italy: no changes to last meeting (Med section applied)
 - Norway: no changes
 - New Zealand: Bernadette/AUS continues to drive the joint P15S application

- UK: AR7E 2025, SR1b 2026/27, A09.5 2028
 - Canada:
 - AR7W (Labrador Sea) – completed, May 22-June 12, 2023 (CCGS Capt. Jacques Cartier), 2024 planned ,
 - ARC02 (Beaufort Sea) - in progress, Sept 14 – Oct 12, 2023 (CCGS Louis S. St-Laurent), 2024 planned
 - Davis Strait – no cruise this year, 2024 planned
 - Line P (Associate line, N. Pacific) : Winter – cancelled, spring - completed May 1-16, 2023 (CCGS Tully), summer – completed Aug 8-24, 2023 (CCGS Tully)
 - Germany: nothing new
 - US:
 - A13.5 slightly shifted Feb to March 2024
 - I08S at almost same time as A13.5
 - ARC01 looking good – but not confirmed
 - A16S maybe late 2024/early2025
 - UK PI (co-CS from US 2023 A16) presently being trained in CFCs in Miami
- Glodap update from Emil: Nico Lange has started his position at NORCE, in the context of GLODAP v3 a discussion came up which kind of metadata standards exist or are required (many cruises do not have any metadata). DMT will start looking at this, and new OCG TT on metrics (open attendance, presently Leticia for GO-SHIP) will also look at harmonized metadata standards across all GOOS networks. First meeting 3 Oct
- Report from data management team: no update from DMT, but Karen reported that CCHDO 5 year application was successful, and has some focus on metadata. Should be itemized in upcoming committee meeting
- Update from working groups (including Bernadette's IAPSO suggestion)
 - Bernadette plans to start writing BP on CTD processing/calibration in October. Katrin volunteered to assist; Yvonne was suggested to join. Karen should be looped in as she leads US BP effort, this particular item being overseen by Laura Stolk
- Review paper Talley et al 2016
 - Elaine would like to kick this off during the February meeting. It should now also include the Med and ARC sections
 - Timing good, as US will in one year start new funding round.
